Subject: NANP-Split of 614 (Ohio) Numbering Plan Area (NPA)

We have been advised by Ameritech that substantial number growth in southeastern Ohio necessitates providing area code relief for the 614 NPA. The relief plan calls for a geographic split of the 614 NPA and the simultaneous introduction of a new 740 NPA. Although the industry has agreed to the relief plan, there is a pending docket before the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio addressing the 614 geographic split boundaries, which may result in modifications to the plan. Details of the relief plan are being released at this time to give the industry the maximum amount of time to prepare for the split of the 614 NPA. The following is a description of the relief plan.

Columbus and the surrounding area including Franklin county and portions of Delaware, Marion, Union, Madison, Fayette, Pickaway, Morrow, Wyandot, Crawford, Licking, Fairfield and Hardin counties will retain the 614 NPA. The remainder of the existing 614 area will receive the 740 NPA.

The split of the 614 NPA, and the beginning of a permissive dialing period, will take place at 12:01 AM Eastern Standard Time (EST) on Saturday, November 8, 1997. The permissive dialing period will end at 12:01 AM EDT on Saturday, June 6, 1998. Note: The permissive period for wireless NXXs moving to the new 740 NPA has been extended to June, 2001. During the permissive dialing period, either the 614 or 740 NPA code will be acceptable in a dialed number terminating in the new 740 NPA. After the permissive period, all calls dialed with the incorrect NPA code will be routed to a recorded announcement and will be blocked.

The attached map illustrates the 614 and 740 NPA configuration after the split. Also attached are listings of the assigned central office codes (NXXs) and the communities in the 614 and 740 NPAs, as of September 8, 1997. Wireless NXXs with an extended permissive dialing period have been identified with an asterisk on the attached NXX listings. Since the attached NXX information may change over time, updated information may be found either in the Local Exchange Routing Guide (LERG) or the NPA NXX Activity Guide (NNAG). Current information in the LERG and NNAG is available by license contract from Bellcore's Traffic Routing Administration (TRA) group, which can be contacted by dialing the TRA Hotline at 732-699-6700.

All international and domestic carriers are asked to ensure that the new 740 NPA has been activated throughout their networks prior to November 8, 1997. Test calls to verify routing to the new NPA can be made by dialing 740-373-7403, effective October 31, 1997. Calls successfully completed to the test number will receive a recorded announcement. The test number will remain in service until June 20, 1998.


The dialing procedures for the 614 and 740 NPAs will be as follows:

- All home NPA (HNPA) local calls will be dialed on a 7-digit basis with no prefix, i.e., NXX-XXXX (7 digits).

- All HNPA toll calls, i.e., calls that generally incur an extra charge, will be dialed with a prefix "1" and 10 digits, i.e., 1 + HNPA-NXX-XXXX (1 + 10 digits).
- All foreign NPA (FNPA) local and toll calls will be dialed with a prefix "1" and 10 digits, i.e., 1 + FNPA-NXX-XXXX (1 + 10 digits).
- All operator assisted calls, including credit card, collect, and third party calls, will be dialed with a "0" prefix and 10 digits, i.e., 0 + NPA-NXX-XXXX (0 + 10 digits).

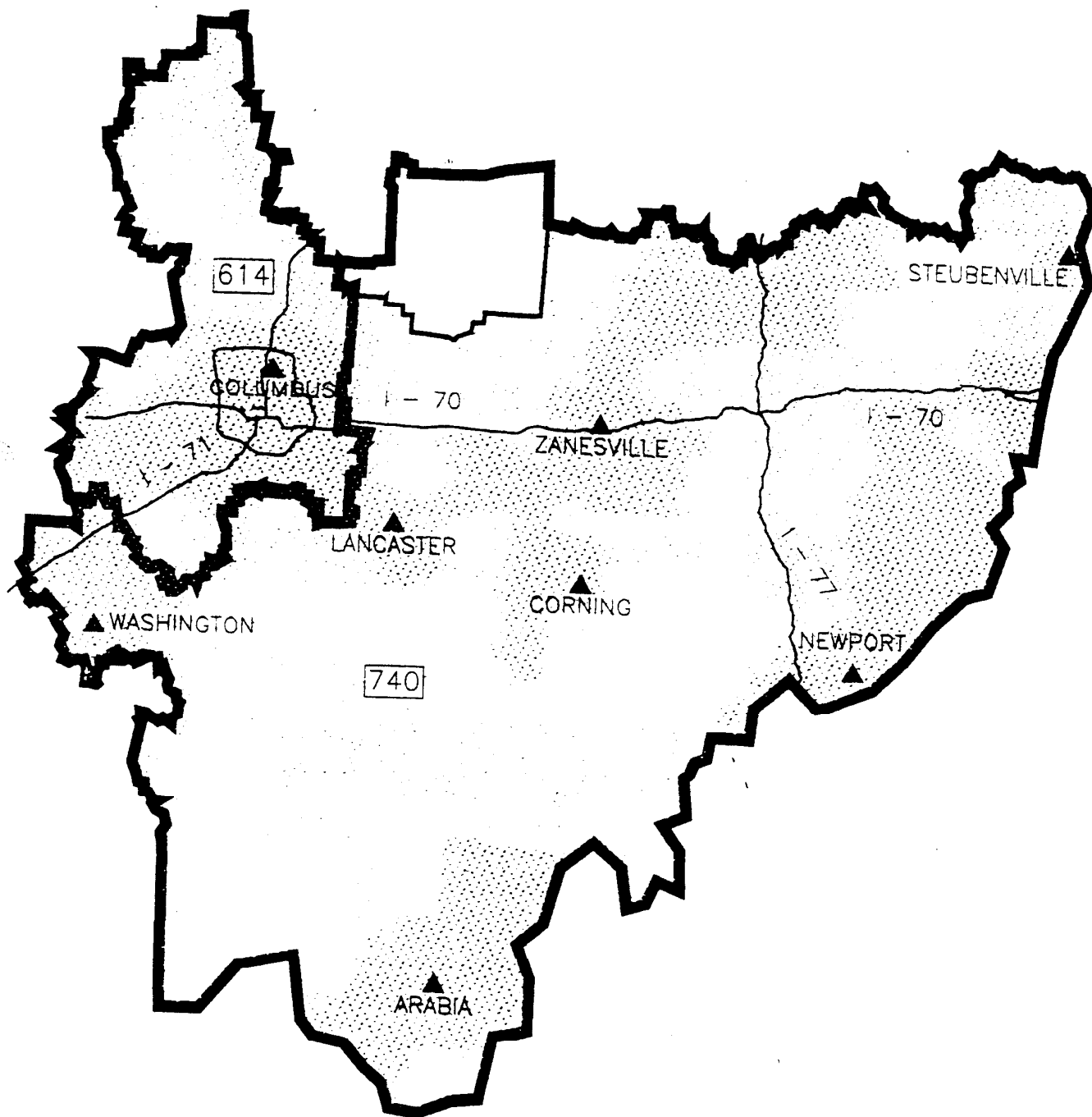
