Subject: Geographic Split of 616 (Michigan) Numbering Plan Area (NPA)

---

Lockheed Martin NPA Administration gives notice that substantial number growth in the Michigan 616 NPA necessitates providing area code relief. The relief plan, approved by the Michigan Public Service Commission, calls for a geographic split of the 616 NPA and the simultaneous introduction of a new 231 NPA. The following is a description of this relief plan.

A list of **exchanges moving to the new 231** NPA is attached. All other exchanges currently in the 616 NPA will remain.

The split of the 616 NPA, and the beginning of a permissive dialing period, will take place at 12:01 AM Eastern Time on Saturday, June 5, 1999. The permissive dialing period will end at 12:01 AM Eastern Time on Saturday, October 2, 1999. During the permissive dialing period, either 616 or 231 NPA code will be acceptable in a dialed number terminating in the new 231 NPA. After the permissive period, all calls dialed with the incorrect NPA code will be routed to intercept.

The **attached map** illustrates the 616 and 231 NPA configuration after the split. Also attached are listings provided by Lockheed Martin Code Administration of the **assigned central office codes (NXXs)** in the 616 and 231 NPAs after the split. The NXX information is effective as of March 2, 1999. Since NXX information may change over time, updated NXX information may be found either in the Local Exchange Routing Guide (LERG) or the NPA NXX Activity Guide (NNAG). Current information in the LERG and NNAG is available by license contract from Bellcore's Traffic Routing Administration (TRA) group, which can be contacted by dialing the TRA Hotline at 732-699-6700.

All international and domestic carriers should ensure that the new 231 NPA has been activated throughout their networks prior to June 5, 1999. Test calls to verify routing to the 231 NPA can be made by dialing the following test number, effective June 5, 1999: 231-922-2572. A recorded

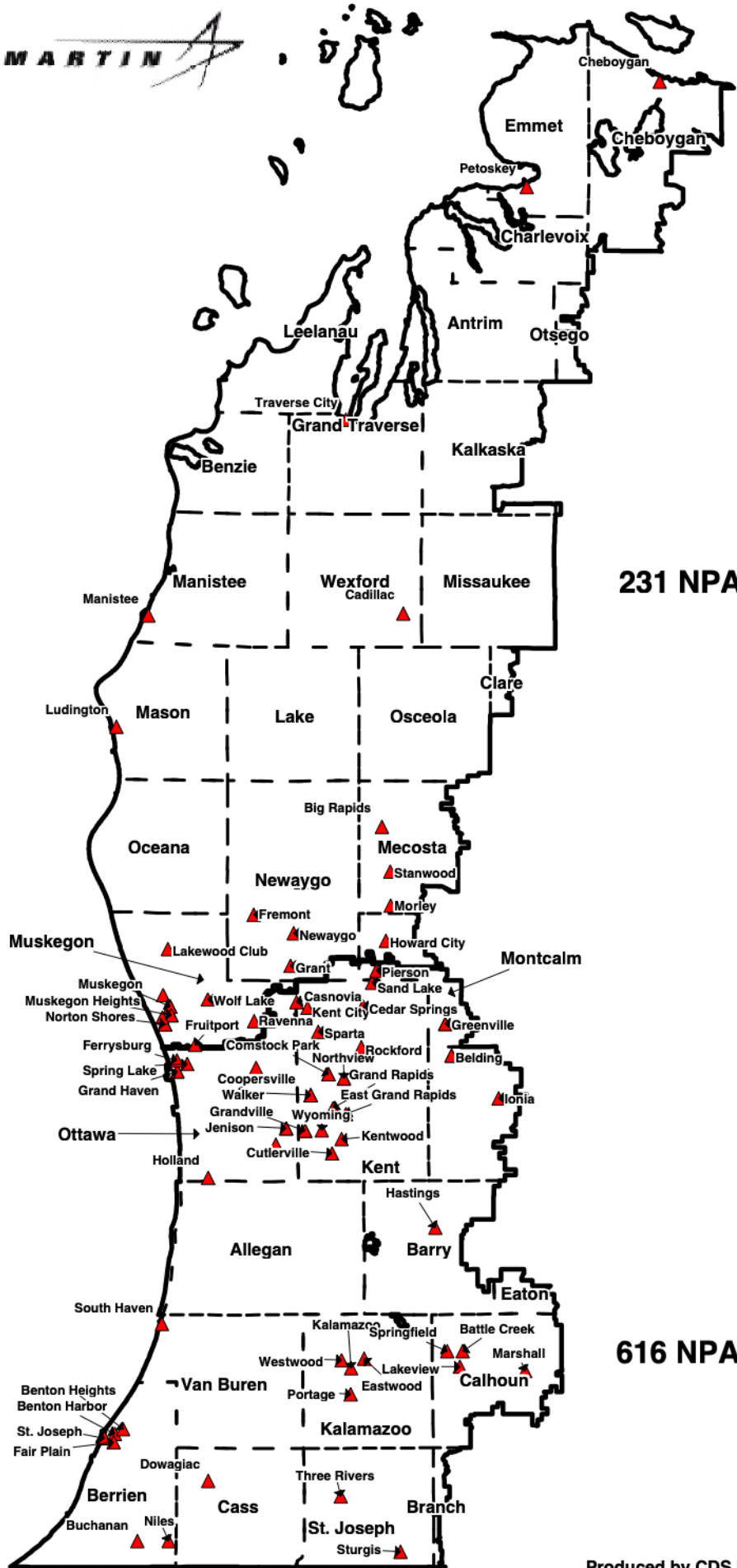
announcement will indicate that the test call has been successfully completed. The test number will be disconnected at the end of permissive dialing on October 2, 1999.

The dialing plan for the 616 and 231 NPAs will be as follows:

- All home NPA (HNPA) local calls will be dialed on a 7-digit basis with no prefix -- i.e. NXX+XXXX (7 digits)
- All HNPA toll calls, i.e., calls that generally incur an extra charge, will require a prefix "1" and 10 digits -- i.e., 1+HNPA+NXX+XXXX (10 digits)
- All foreign NPA (FNPA) local calls will be dialed on a 10-digit basis with no prefix -- i.e., FNPA+NXX+XXXX (10 digits)
- All FNPA toll calls will be dialed with a prefix "1" and 10 digits -- i.e., 1+FNPA+NXX+XXXX (1 + 10 digits)
- All operator assisted calls, including credit card, collect, and third party calls, will be dialed with a "0" prefix and 10 digits -- i.e., 0+NPA+NXX+XXXX (0 + 10 digits)
