Subject: Supplemental Information NPA SPLIT 912/478/229 Georgia

In Docket No.9066-U, the Georgia Public Service Commission (GPSC) approved a three way split for the 912 NPA in South Georgia, creating NPAs 478 and 229. The new NPAs were placed in service with the beginning of the one-year permissive dialing period on August 1, 2000, with mandatory dialing to begin on August 1, 2001. Planning Letter PL-NANPA-202 was issued December 6, 1999 addressing this NPA split.

NANPA has received supplemental direction from the GPSC indicating that six cross-NPA boundary local routes are to remain 7-digit dialing. The following six local, cross-boundary routes are to retain 7-digit local dialing after the mandatory dialing date of the NPA split on August 1, 2001:

Lexy	to and from	Swainsboro
Oak Park	to and from	Swainsboro
Metter	to and from	Twin City
Waynesboro	to and from	Sardis
Waynesboro	to and from	Millen
