Subject: VA 540 NPA Order of Dismissal

On February 22, 2001 the Virginia State Corporation Commission (SCC) approved a phased implementation of a three-way geographic split as the relief method for the 540 NPA (PUC990207). In the first phase the 540 NPA was split between Southwest Virginia, which was assigned the 276 NPA, and the Roanoke and upper Shenandoah Valleys, which retained the 540 NPA. Mandatory dialing for the new 276 NPA in the first phase of the three-way split began March 16, 2002

On October 17, 2007 the SCC issued an order of dismissal for the second phase of the three-way split (CASE No. PUC-1999-00207) since the commission was informed by the Staff that the latest projection shows the 540 area code, Roanoke and upper Shenandoah Valleys, will not exhaust until 2015.

The information in this planning letter reflects detailed information about NPA relief activities. The information has been derived from commission orders and from industry implementation decisions. The implementation of the plan described in this letter is the responsibility of individual service providers, and NANPA does not guarantee that the activities and plans will occur exactly as described herein.
