Subject: NPA 531 to Overlay NPA 402 (Nebraska)

General Description

On June 30, 2009, the Nebraska Public Service Commission (PSC) in Case 4152 approved an all services overlay as the relief method for the 402 NPA which generally serves the eastern portion of the state. The 402 NPA serves cities and communities such as Bellevue, Columbus, Fremont, Hastings, Lincoln, Norfolk, Omaha, and Valentine. The new **531 NPA** will serve the same geographic area currently served by the existing 402 NPA.

Implementation of Relief Plan

There will be a permissive dialing period for customers to adjust to the change to 10-digit dialing. During the permissive dialing period, subscribers may dial local calls within the overlay area on either a 7-digit or 10-digit basis, but will be encouraged to dial 10-digits. After the permissive period ends, all calls must be dialed using 10-digits. Implementation interval dates of the overlay with the 531 NPA will be determined at a later date.
