General Description

This planning letter is issued to announce the dismissal of previously suspended NPA relief projects. The California Public Utilities Commission had approved overlays for the 415 and 510 NPAs but suspended them before implementation; it also approved and implemented only the first phase of a 3-way split for the 619 NPA leaving the 619/935 NPA split suspended; it also approved the 3-way split of the 707 NPA but it was suspended before the implementation of the 369 and 627 NPAs started.

These four NPAs however have been held in rationing by the CPUC and NANPA has kept them in jeopardy status.

On June 16, 2011, the CPUC eliminated the rationing for these NPAs thus allowing NANPA to rescind the jeopardy condition. Therefore, with the CPUC's May 3, 2007 decision (D-07-05-011) which determined that all previously filed requests for area code relief that remain pending are dismissed as moot, NANPA publishes this planning letter to reflect the NPA relief projects for the 415, 619, 650 and 707 NPAs as dismissed. NANPA will retain the assigned relief NPAs as the reserved future NPAs for these area codes unless otherwise specified by the CPUC. When NANPA determines any of these NPAs are in need of area code relief a new project will be initiated and a new application for relief will be submitted to the CPUC.
