Subject: NPA 813 and 656 All-Services Overlay (Florida)
Related Previous Planning Letters: 541

This planning letter supersedes PL-541. On December 4, 2020 the Florida Public Service Commission (PSC) in Docket No. 20200236-TP, Order No. PSC-2020-0479-PAA-TP, ordered an extension of the permissive dialing period. This planning letter includes revised implementation and network testing intervals for the 813/656 NPA overlay.

General Description

On March 31, 2020 the Florida PSC in Docket No. 20190196-TP, approved an all-services distributed overlay as the relief method for the 813 NPA. On April 10, 2020, the PSC filed PAA Order PSC-2020-0098-PAA-TP. On May 4, 2020, the Consummating Order, Order No. PSC-2020-0134-CO-TP was filed and Order No. PSC-2020-0098-PAA-TP became final. The 813 NPA currently serves the greater metropolitan area of Tampa and also includes cities Oldsmar, Temple Terrace, Plant City and Zephyrhills. The 813 NPA serves mainly the Hillsborough and Pasco counties. The new 656 NPA will serve the same geographic area currently served by the existing 813 NPA. Additionally, the order specifies that central office codes in the 656 NPA will be available for assignment only when all assignable prefixes in the 813 area code have been assigned.

Implementation of Relief Plan

Implementation of the 813/656 NPA overlay is as follows:

During the permissive dialing period, subscribers may dial calls within the overlay area on either a 7-digit or 10-digit basis, but will be encouraged to dial 10-digits. After the permissive period ends, all calls must be dialed using 10-digits.

Dialing Plan

Coincident with the introduction of mandatory 10-digit dialing on January 22, 2022, the dialing plan for the 813 and 656 NPAs will be as follows:

Local call	Home NPA (HNPA) or Foreign NPA (FNPA)	10-digits (NPA-NXX-XXXX)*
Toll call	HNPA or FNPA	1 + 10-digits (1 + NPA-NXX-XXXX)
Operator Services Credit card, collect, third party	HNPA or FNPA	0 + 10-digits (0 + NPA-NXX-XXXX)

*1+10 digit permissible at each service provider’s discretion

Network Testing

All international and domestic carriers should ensure that the new 656 NPA has been activated throughout their networks prior to February 22, 2022. The test number to verify the routing to the 656 NPA will be in service beginning November 22, 2021 through March 22, 2022. The test number to verify the routing to the 656 NPA is: 656-656-1656. A recorded announcement will indicate the test call has been successfully completed.

General Information

The information in this planning letter reflects detailed information about NPA relief activities. The information has been derived from commission orders and from industry implementation decisions. The implementation of the plan described in this letter is the responsibility of individual service providers, and NANPA does not guarantee that the activities and plans will occur exactly as described herein.
